

STEPHEN ROSENTHAL

(1935, vive e lavora a New York, US)

Stephen Rosenthal, già attivo a New York dalla seconda metà degli anni '60, ha esplorato fin dall'inizio un'indagine di riduzione della pittura attraverso una ricerca del lavoro realizzato su tele sprovviste di telaio, esaminate in cicli successivi, fino agli ultimi *Microcosmi* del periodo recente. Rosenthal crea l'opera esattamente nel momento in cui dipinge la tela; ma quando il lavoro sembra essere finito, inizia un processo di eliminazione inverso, usando dell'acido, rimuovendo quasi completamente ciò che era stato fatto e lasciando tracce minimali, in equilibrio tra caso e design, ricordi di ciò che esisteva una volta.
